- Total 2018 reach is **<u>306,985</u>** in Prairies and Ontario
- <u>Highlights</u> include:
 - ✓ Twenty Three Fire departments (over **200** members) in Alberta, Saskatchewan and Ontario have been trained in grain rescue.
 - ✓ Launched FREE online <u>Introduction to Grain Handling and Storage Hazards</u>. Geared to both producers and fire fighters.
 - ✓ CASA has received booking requests into late 2019 in Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario and Quebec.
 - ✓ Collaboration in spreading awareness to rural communities continues to remain strong with the help from towns, fire departments, and provincial agricultural health and safety specialists.
 - ✓ Ten rescue tubes and augers have been awarded by G3 to Saskatchewan fire departments that have completed training.
 - ✓ Funding has been awarded by Nutrien to Spirit River fire department for a rescue tube and auger.



<u>Challenges</u>

- Securing space at large agriculture shows. Ag in Motion, Ag Expo, Crop Production Show, AgriTrade are all sold out with waitlists. To resolve this we have directed our efforts to demo at the community organized events which works out very well.
- ✓ Trailer transport costs remain high.
