




# **Canada: Oat Production**



\*2021 was a severe drought year in Western Canada resulting in a large reduction in production.









Saskatchewan typically produces more than 50% of Canadian oats each year.

#### Western Canadian Seeded Oat Area by Agricultural District











## **Canada: Total Oat Exports**


(grain and product – 000 tonnes)


